- **Relay teams: \$100** for 3 to 5 members through October 8th & **\$125** on October 9th. No race day registration for Relay teams.

Take I-10 to Redd Rd. exit then East to Resler, turn left. Race start line at GECU, 1500 N. Resler. Parking will be available in staging area.

Buses will transport 1/2 Marathon finishers from finish line back to Start area starting at 8:30 a.m.

The TransMountain exit will be closed to traffic the morning of the race.

The 1/2 Marathon course will go over the mountain, turning right on Gateway South, left on Diana, left on Gateway North, right on Cohen Ave. to finish.

The 5K course will start & finish on Cohen Ave.
